

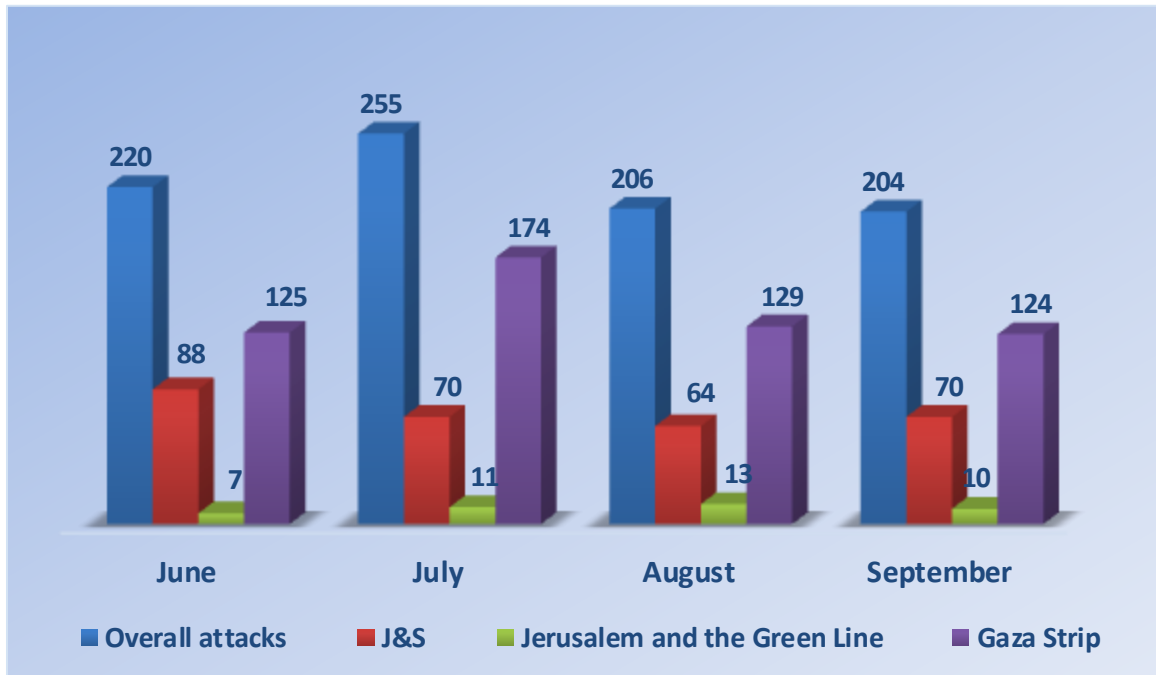
Monthly Summary – September 2018

In September 2018, **204 terrorist attacks** took place (including 127 firebomb attacks), compared to 206 in August 2018.

In Judea and Samaria, 70 attacks were executed in September, as opposed to August's 64. **10 attacks** took place in **Jerusalem**, down from 12 in the preceding month. **No attacks** were executed **within the Green Line** in September, whereas one such attack had taken place in August. Finally, **124 attacks originated from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula** in September (including 66 firebomb attacks), compared to 129 in August.

One member of the security forces was slightly injured by a grenade in the Gaza Strip area on 21 September.

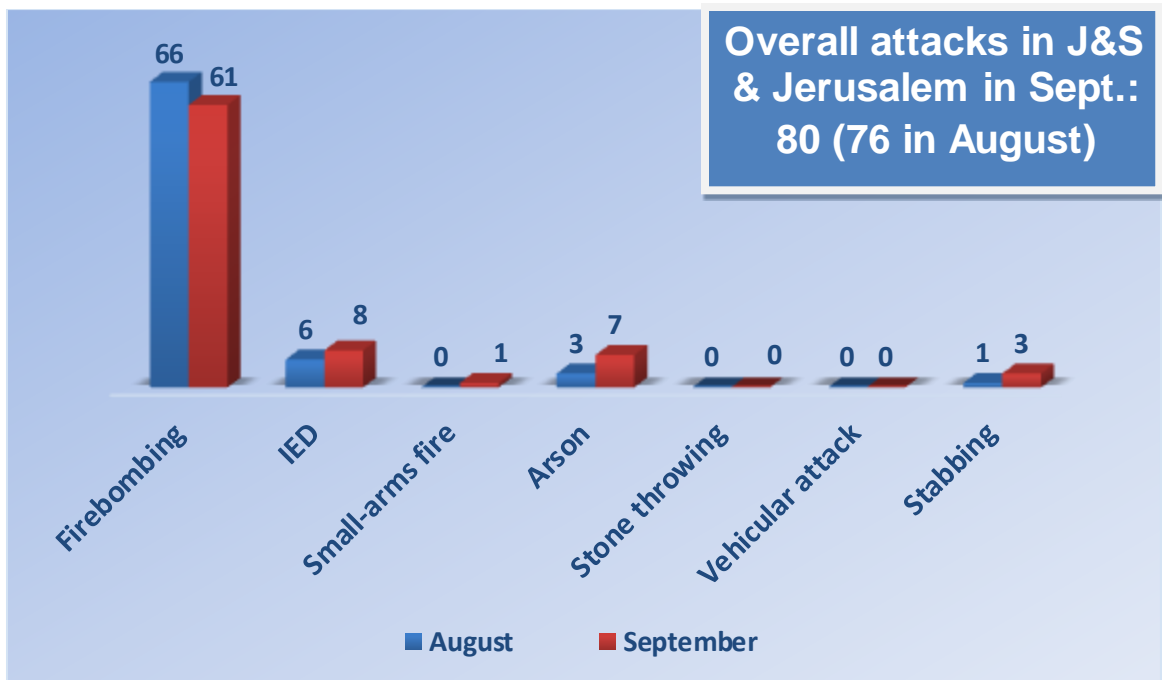
Distribution of Attacks in September 2018,
Compared to Preceding Months:



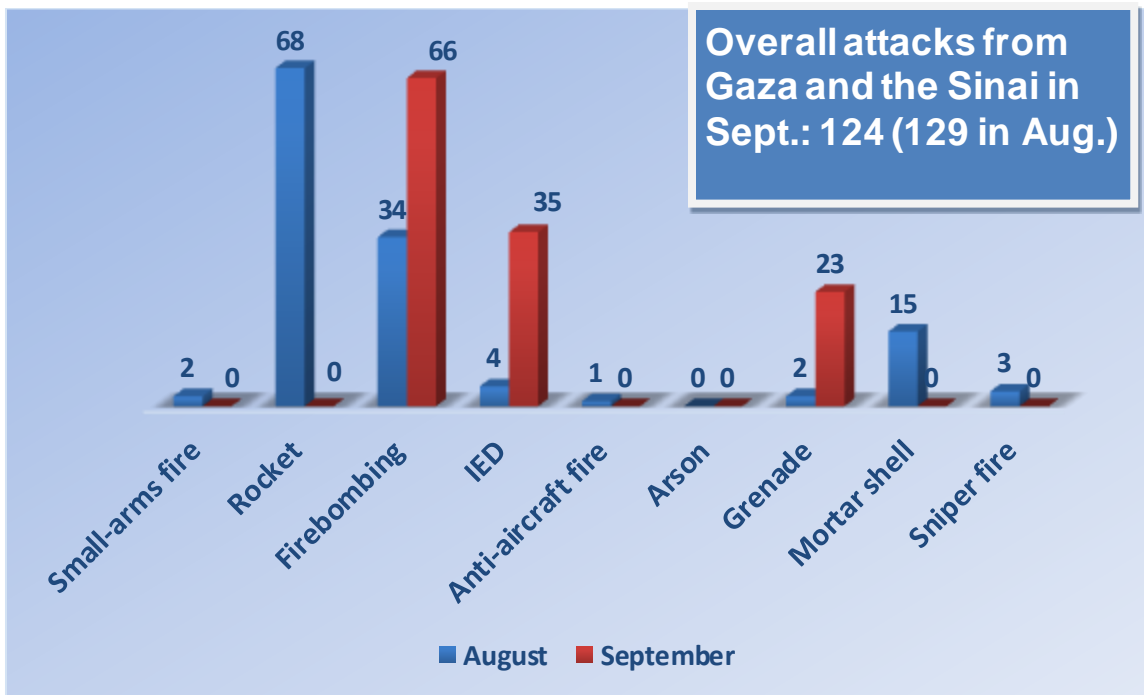
Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in September 2018
by Region and Type of Attack

In Jerusalem and J&S – 80 attacks: eight IEDs (including improvised grenades and pipe bombs); 61 firebomb attacks; three stabbings; one shooting; and seven arsons.

In September 2018, no rocket-launching* attacks were directed from the Gaza Strip at Israel. 83 such attacks (with 212 launches) had taken place in August.

**Clarification: The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example: one attack may consist of three launches, that is, three rockets / mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launches.*
