

## Monthly Summary – June 2017

June 2017 saw a **decrease in the number of attacks: 94 attacks** (including 80 firebomb attacks), compared to 144 in May.

**In Judea and Samaria, 72 attacks** were executed in June, compared to 113 in May. **21 attacks** took place **in Jerusalem**, compared to May's 29. **No attacks** were executed **within the Green Line**, compared to one in May. Finally, **one attack originated from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula** this month, as in the month before.

**One Israeli female police officer was stabbed to death** this month in the Old City of Jerusalem and two security personnel were injured (16 June).

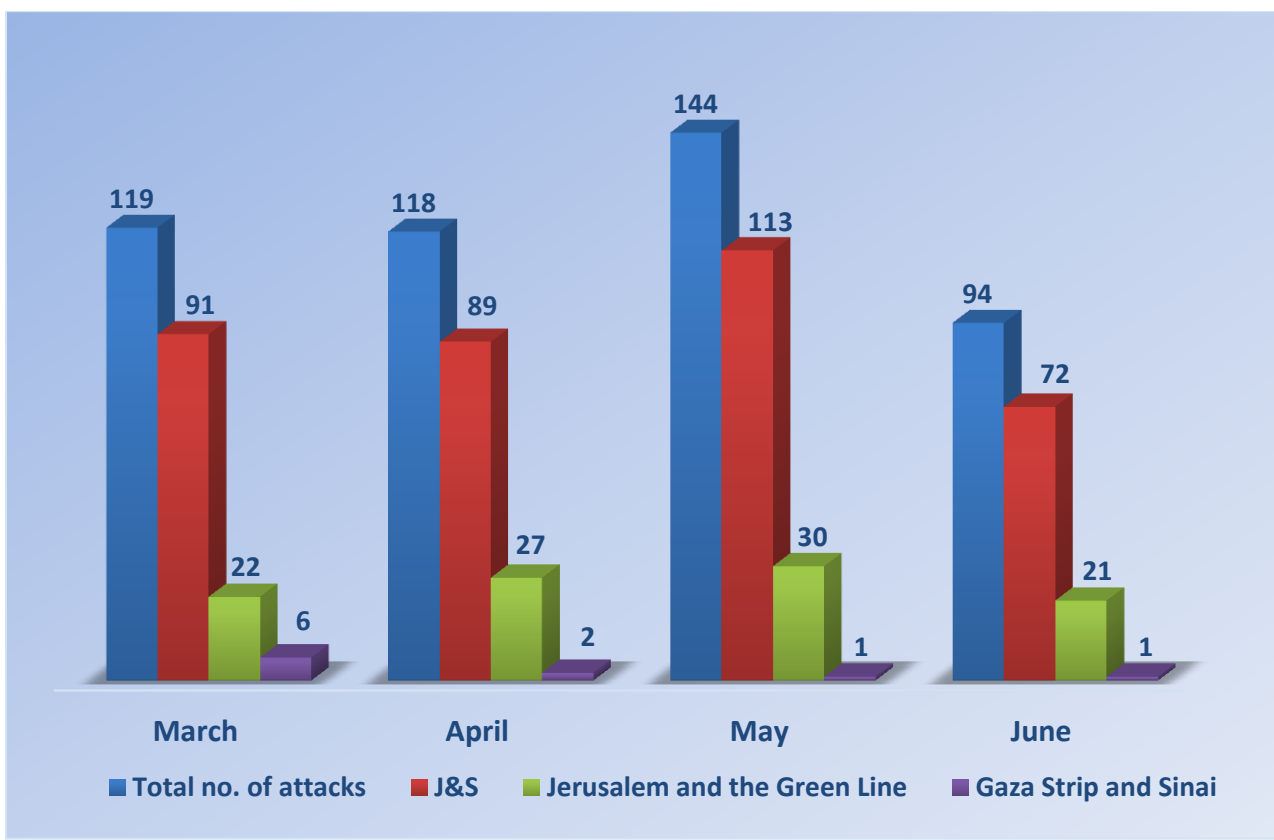
One soldier was injured in a stabbing attack at Mevo Dotan (1 June).

## Data on Terrorist Attacks in June 2017

The distribution of terrorist attacks by region was as follows: one attack from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula (compared to one in May); 72 attacks in Judea and Samaria (113 in May); 21 attacks in Jerusalem (29 in May); and no attacks within the Green Line (one in May).

Once again, most of the attacks in Jerusalem and J&S (80 out of 93) in June were **firebomb attacks**. In May, 121 out of 142 attacks in these regions involved firebombs.

## Distribution of terrorist attacks in June by region and type of attack

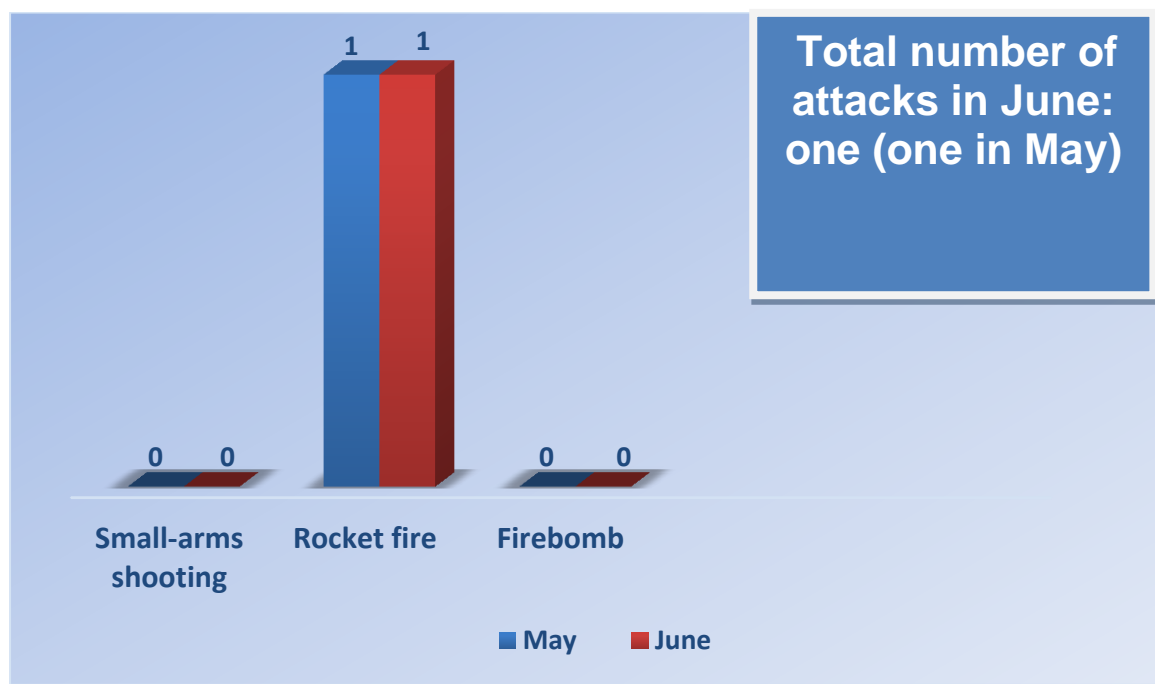
From the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula – one attack: one rocket-fire attack from the Gaza Strip.

In Jerusalem and J&S – 93 attacks: 6 IEDs (including improvised grenades and pipe bombs); three stabbing attacks; four instances of small-arms shooting; and 80 firebomb attacks (including 19 in Jerusalem).

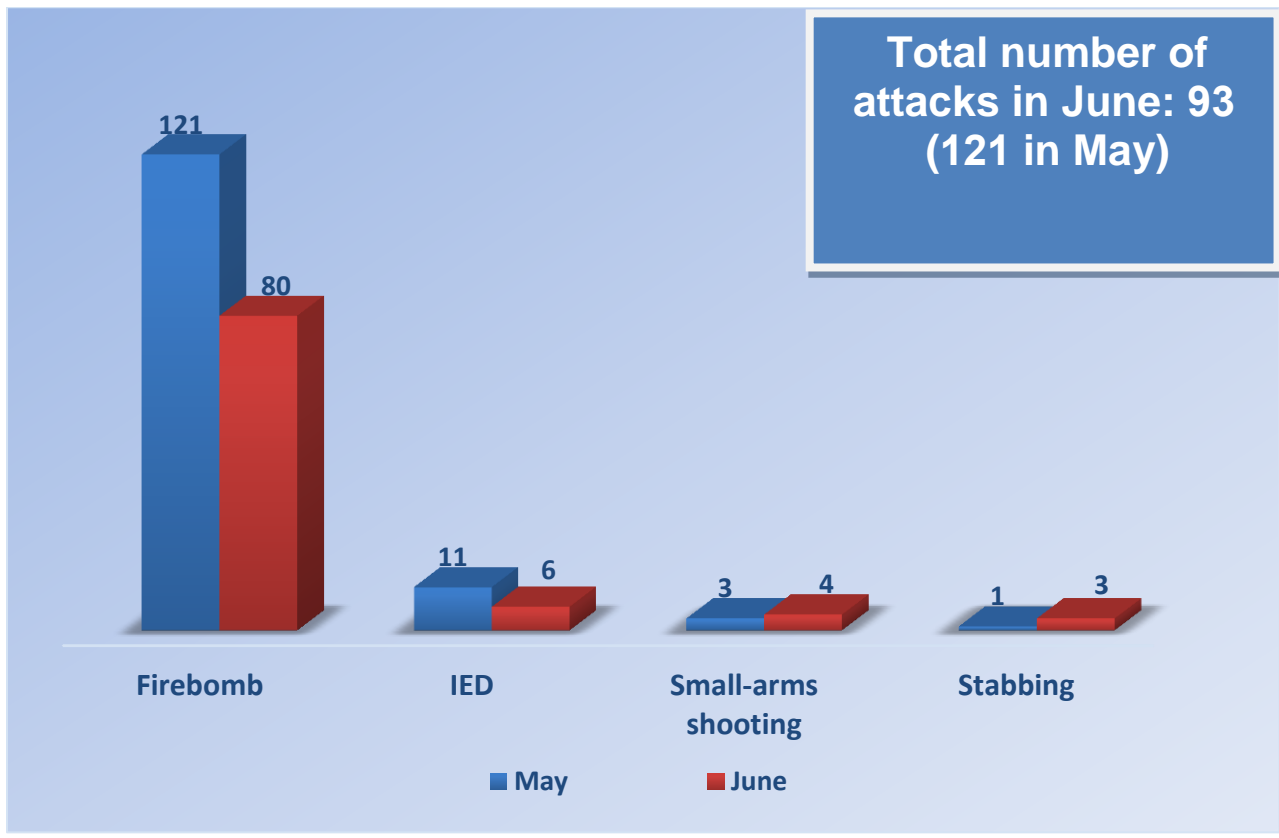
Within the Green Line – No attacks.

In June 2017, one rocket was launched\* from the Gaza Strip at Israel. In May, one rocket was launched from the Sinai at Israel.

**\*Clarification:** The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example: one attack may include a salvo of three launchings, that is, three rockets/mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launchings.
