

Monthly summary – February 2015

February 2015 **witnessed a considerable decrease in the number of terrorist attacks**, compared to last month: **96** as opposed to 124 in January.

The decrease was evident in **Judea and Samaria, with 84 terrorist attacks** as opposed to 105 in January, and **Jerusalem, with 12 attacks** as opposed to 18. **In the Gaza Strip no attacks were carried out in February**, similarly to January 2015.

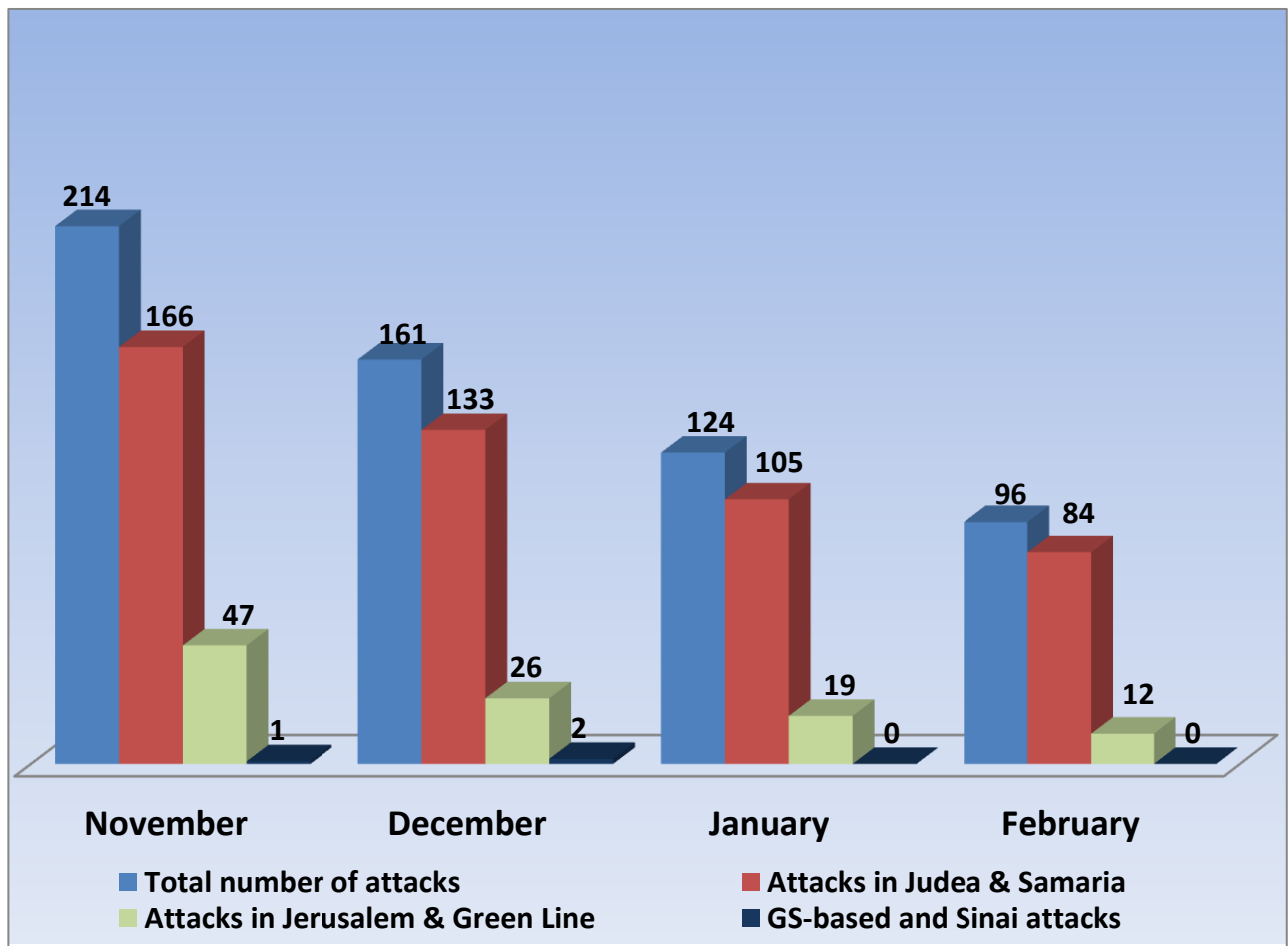
An Israeli was moderately injured in a stabbing attack at Jerusalem's Safra Square on 22 February.

Data regarding terror attacks in February 2015

Following is a regional distribution of attacks: **0** attack from the Gaza Strip, (as in January); **84** attacks in the Judea and Samaria (105 in January); **12** attacks in Jerusalem (18 in January).

Jerusalem and the Judea and Samaria area: **Most attacks executed in February 76 out of 96 were in the form of firebombs** (January: 102 out of 123).

Distribution of attacks according to regions and pattern profile:

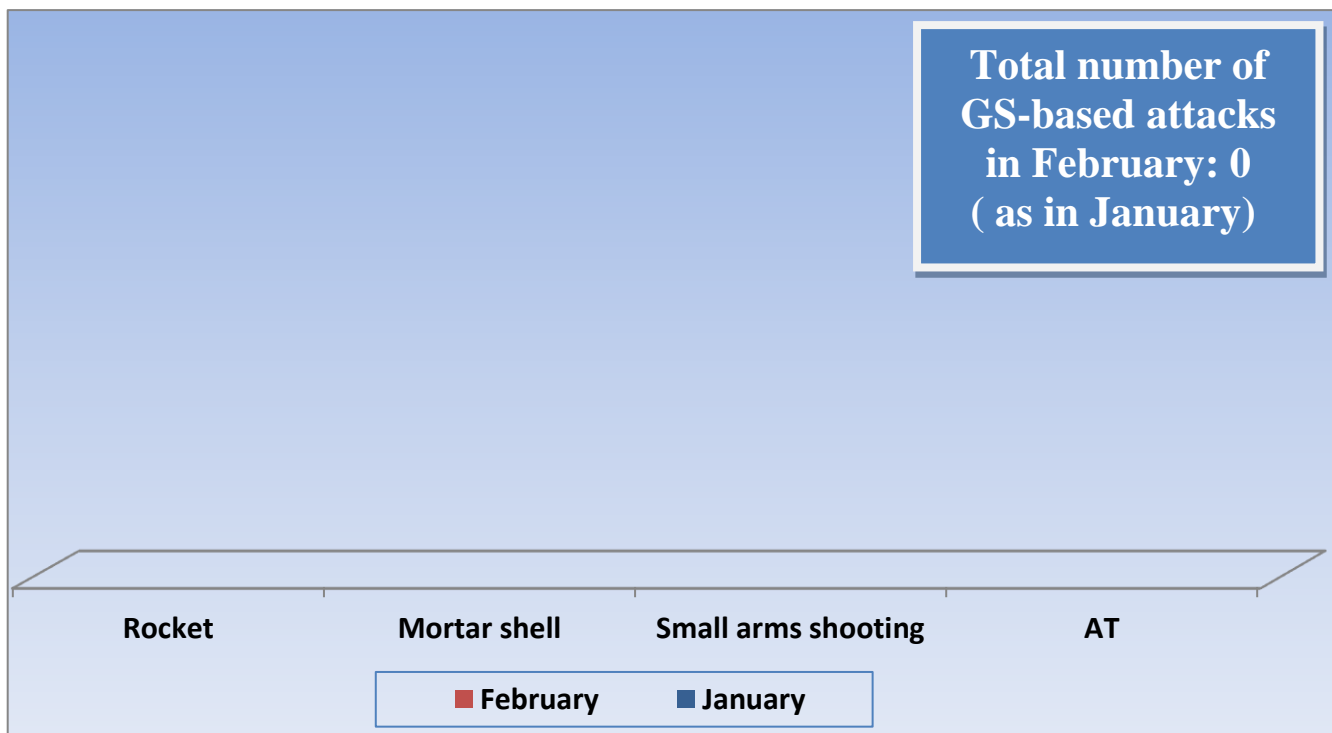
Following is a distribution of attacks in February 2015 according to regions:

The Gaza Strip – 0 attack.

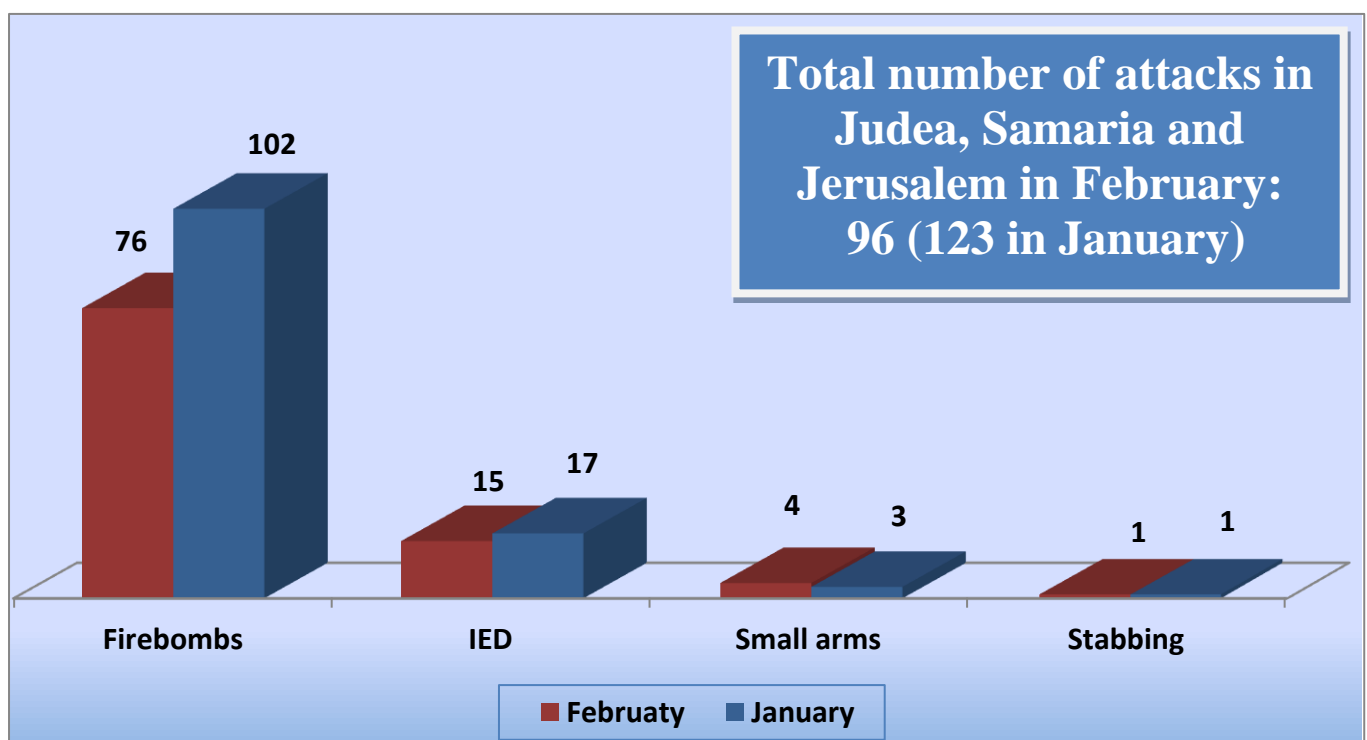
Judea, Samaria and Jerusalem – 96 attacks: 15 IED (including pipe bombs and improvised grenade); 4 small arms shooting; 1 stabbing attacks (in Jerusalem); 76 firebombs (11 in Jerusalem).

High-trajectory launchings from Gaza Strip and Sinai

Throughout February 2015 no rockets or mortar shells were launched** from the Gaza Strip or Sinai towards Israel, the same as in January.

****Clarification:** The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example: one attack may include a salvo of three launchings, that is, three rockets/ mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launchings.
