Monthly Summary – January 2017

The number of attacks in January 2017 was similar to that of the previous month: 100 (including 81 firebomb attacks), compared to 98 in December.

In Judea and Samaria, 82 attacks were executed in January, compared to 87 in December. 16 attacks were carried out in Jerusalem, compared to December's 10. One attack was executed within the **Green Line** (no attacks in December), and one attack originated from the **Gaza Strip**, as in December.

January's terror attacks killed 5 Israelis (one civilian and four security personnel) and wounded another 16 (one civilian and 15 security personnel). Most of these casualties (4 fatalities and 13 non-fatal casualties) resulted from the truck-ramming attack at the Armon Hanatziv promenade in Jerusalem on 8 January. Additionally, a shooting attack in Haifa on 3 January killed an Israeli civilian and moderately injured another.


Two security personnel were wounded as a result of **IED attacks in al-Moayer/Binyamin** (23 January) **and Jenin refugee camp** (26 January) – one suffered mild injuries, while the other was moderately wounded.

Data regarding terror attacks in January 2017:

Following is a regional distribution of attacks: 1 attack from the Gaza Strip (1 in December); 82 attacks in Judea and Samaria (87 in December); 16 attacks in Jerusalem (10 in December); 1 attack within the Green Line.

Jerusalem and the J&S area – in January, as in the previous month, most attacks (81 out of 100) were firebomb attacks (December: 67 out of 97 attacks).

Following is the distribution of attacks compared to previous months:




Following is the distribution of attacks executed in January by region and type of attack:

One attack from the **Gaza Strip** – a shooting attack.


In <u>J&S and Jerusalem</u> – 98 attacks: 11 IED attacks (including pipe bombs and improvised grenades); 5 small arms shooting attacks; 1 ramming attack (in Jerusalem); 81 firebomb attacks (14 in Jerusalem).

Within the <u>Green Line</u> – a shooting attack in Haifa.

Throughout January 2017, as in December 2016, no rockets or mortar shells were launched** from the Gaza Strip toward Israel.

** <u>Clarification</u>: the number of launches is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example, one attack may include a salvo of three launches, that is, three rockets/mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launches.
