

Monthly Summary – June 2018

June 2018 saw a **significant decrease in the number of attacks: 220** (including 155 firebomb attacks), compared to 365 in May 2018.

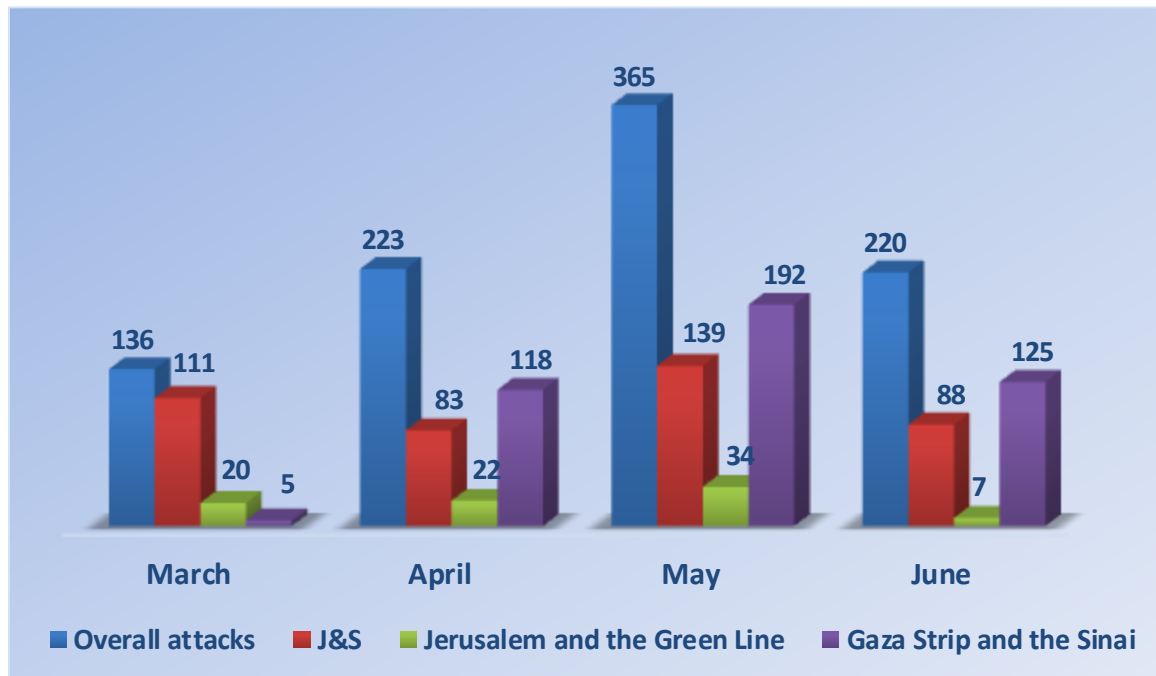
In Judea and Samaria, 88 attacks were executed in June, compared to May's 139. **6 attacks** took place **in Jerusalem**, down from 34 in the preceding month. **One attack** was executed **within the Green Line** in June, as opposed to none in May. Finally, **125 attacks originated from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula** in June (including 78 firebomb attacks), compared to 192 in May.

Five Israelis were injured in terrorist attacks in June 2018. One member of the security forces was slightly injured by a firebomb in East Jerusalem on 5 June. A civilian was moderately wounded in a stabbing in Afula on 11 June. Finally, three security personnel were slightly injured in a vehicular attack near Bethlehem on 23 June.

Data on Terrorist Attacks in June 2018

The distribution of terrorist attacks by region in June 2018 was as follows: 125 attacks from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula (192 in May); 88 attacks in Judea and Samaria (139 in May); 6 attacks in Jerusalem (34 in May); and one within the Green Line (none in May).

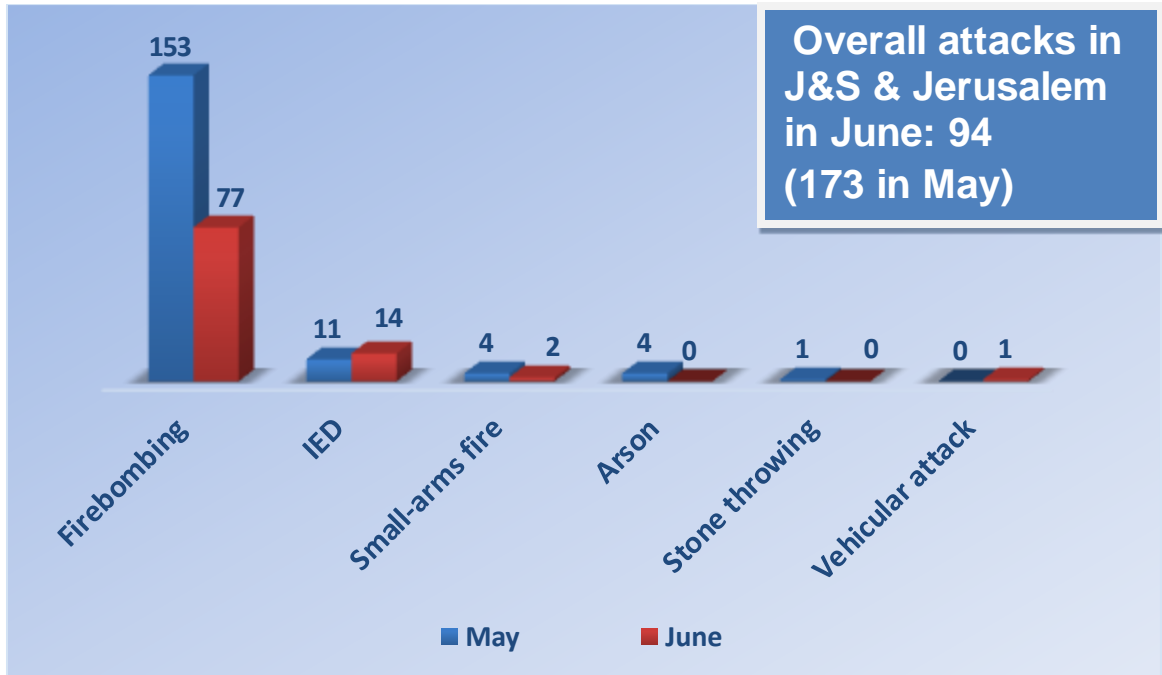
Distribution of Attacks in June 2018, Compared to Preceding Months:



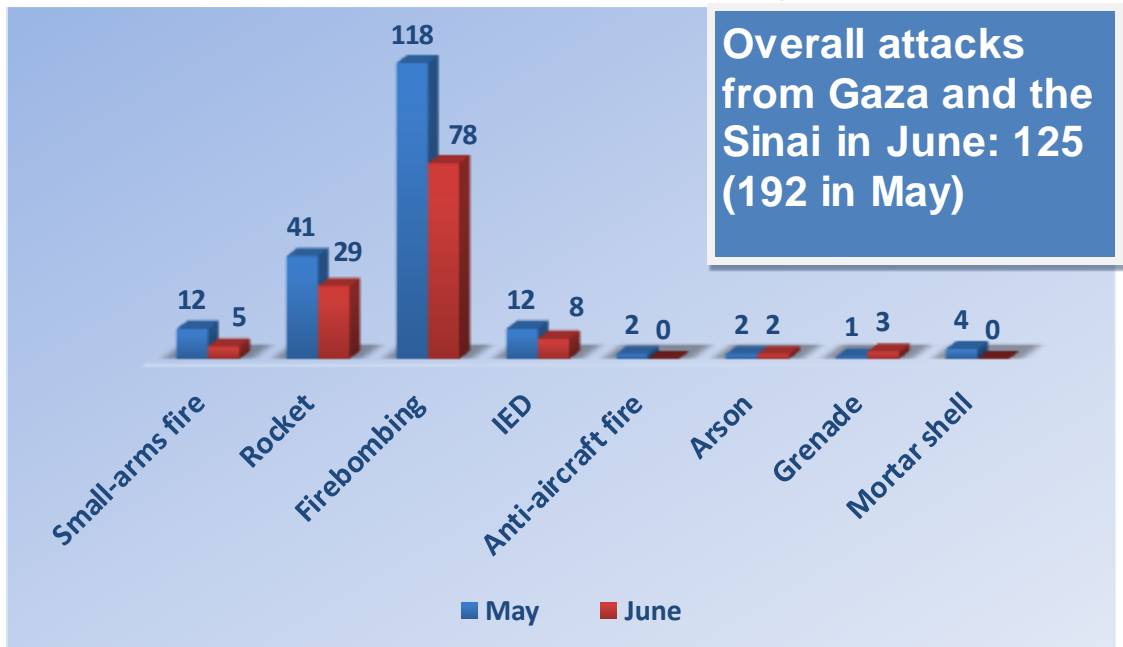
Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in June 2018 by Region and Type of Attack

In Jerusalem and J&S – 94 attacks: 14 IEDs (including improvised grenades and pipe bombs); two small-arms shootings; 77 firebomb attacks (six of them in Jerusalem); and one vehicular attack.

In June 2018, 29 rocket-launching* attacks (with 76 launches) were directed from the Gaza Strip at Israel. 45 such attacks (with 188 launches) had taken place in May.

***Clarification:** The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example: one attack may consist of three launches, that is, three rockets / mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launches.
