

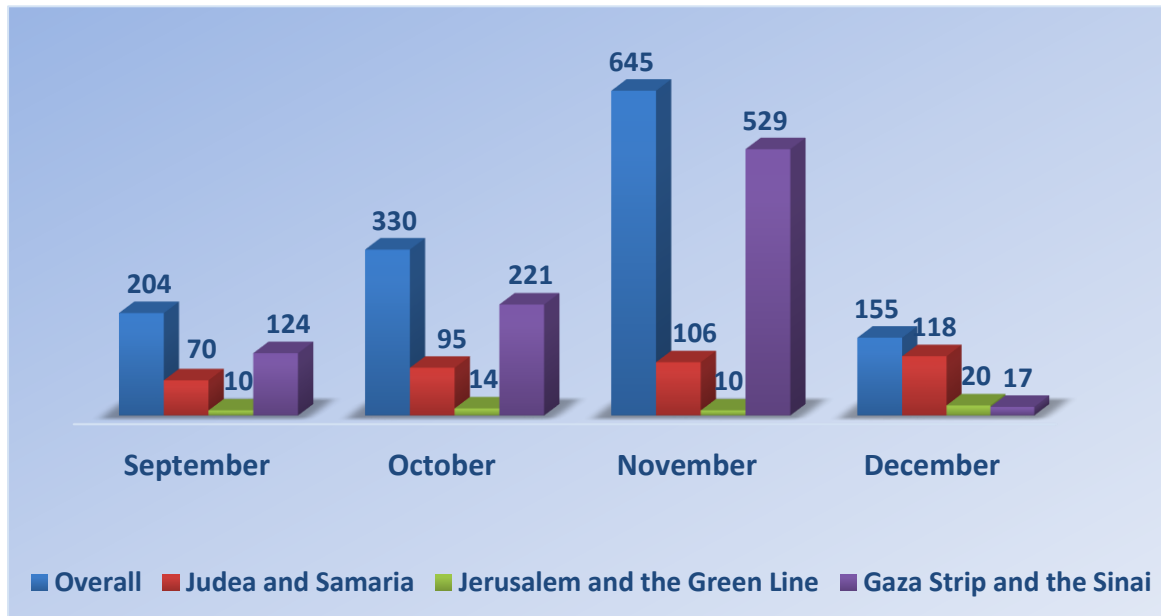
Monthly Summary – December 2018

December 2018 saw a **significant drop in the number of terrorist attacks: 155**, compared to 645 in November 2018.

In Judea and Samaria, 118 attacks were executed in December, compared to November's 106. **20 attacks** took place **in Jerusalem**, up from 8 in the preceding month. **No attacks** were executed **within the Green Line** in December, while two had taken place in November. Finally, **just 17 attacks originated from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula** in December, as opposed to 529 in November.

Three people were killed and fourteen were injured by terrorist activity in December 2018. **One civilian was killed and seven injured (six of them slightly)** in a shooting at Ofra Junction on 9 December. **Two security personnel were killed and two other people – one civilian and one member of the security forces – were injured** in a shooting at Giv'at Asaf on 13 December. **Two security personnel were wounded (one moderately and the other slightly)** in a stabbing in Jerusalem on 13 December. **One member of the security forces was slightly injured** in a vehicular attack in Ramallah on 13 December. **One member of the security forces was injured** in a stabbing in Beit El on 14 December. Finally, **one civilian was wounded** in a stone throwing attack in Beka'ot on 16 December.

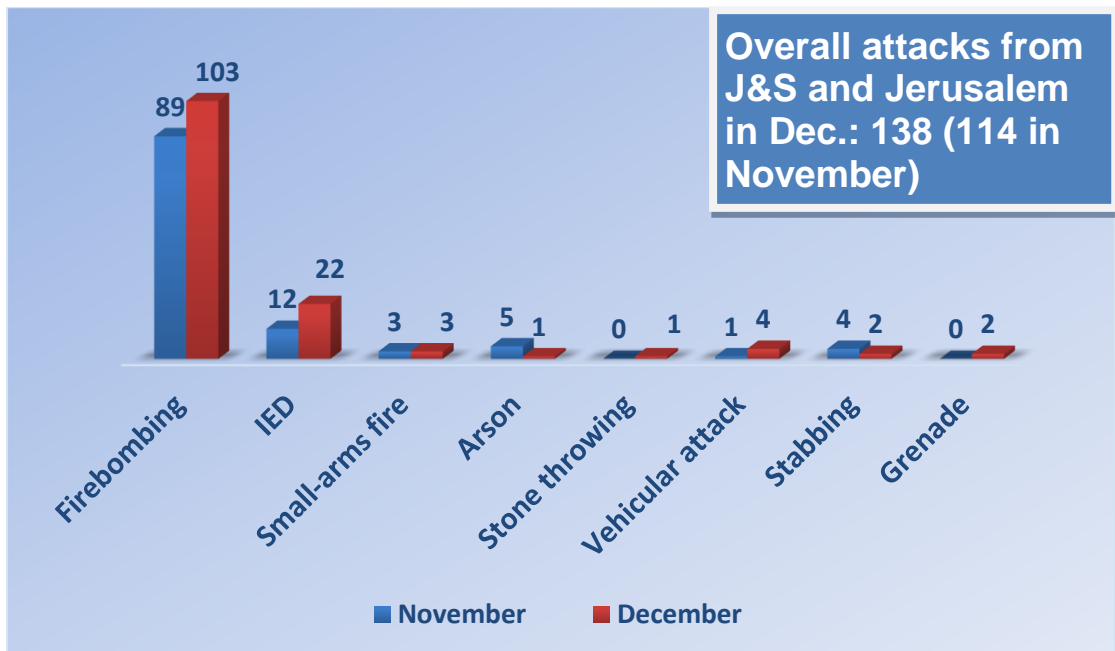
Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in December 2018,
Compared to Preceding Months:



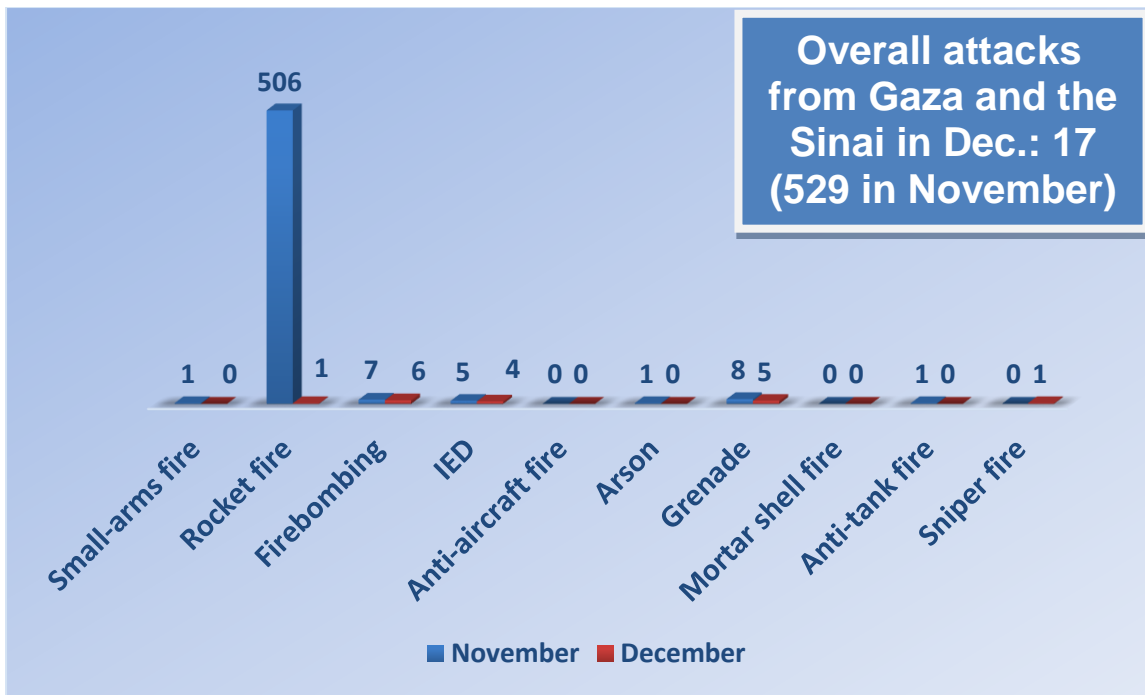
Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in December 2018
by Region and Type of Attack

In Judea & Samaria and Jerusalem – 138 attacks: 103 firebombs; 22 pipe bombs; four vehicular attacks; three shootings; two stabbings; two grenade attacks; one stone throwing attack; and one arson.

High-trajectory Fire from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula

In December 2018, one high-trajectory rocket-launching* attack was directed from the Gaza Strip at Israel, compared to 506 such rocket-launching attacks in November.

***Clarification:** The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one high-trajectory fire attack. For example: one attack may consist of three launches, that is, three rockets / mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launches.
