

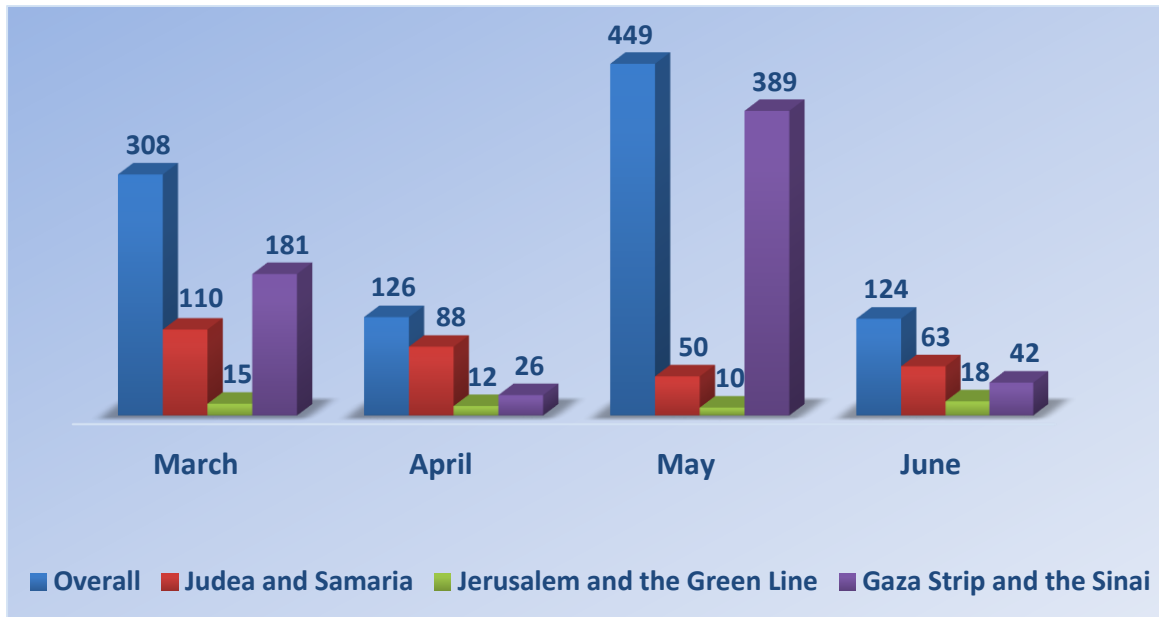
## **Monthly Summary – June 2019**

**June 2019 saw a significant drop in the number of terrorist attacks, compared to May: 123, as opposed to 449.**

**42 attacks originated from the Gaza Strip and the Sinai Peninsula in June, down dramatically from 389 in May. In Judea and Samaria, 63 attacks were executed, compared to 50 in May. 18 attacks took place in Jerusalem, as opposed to ten in the preceding month. Finally, no attacks were executed within the Green Line, similarly to May.**

**There were no casualties from terrorist activity in June 2019.**

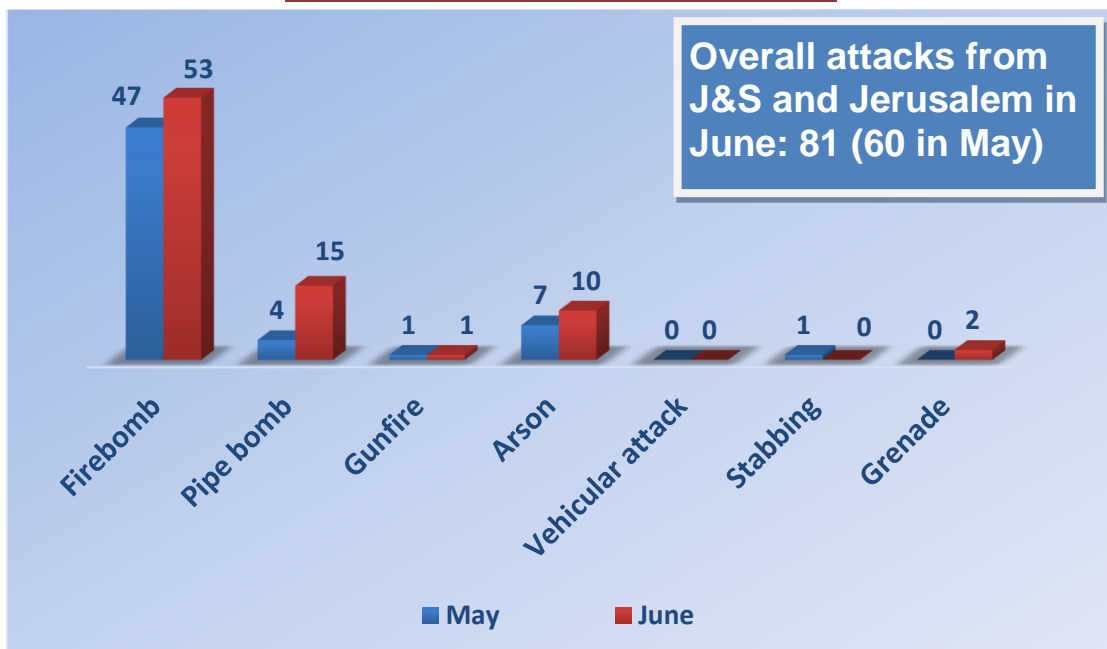
**Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in June 2019,  
Compared to Preceding Months**



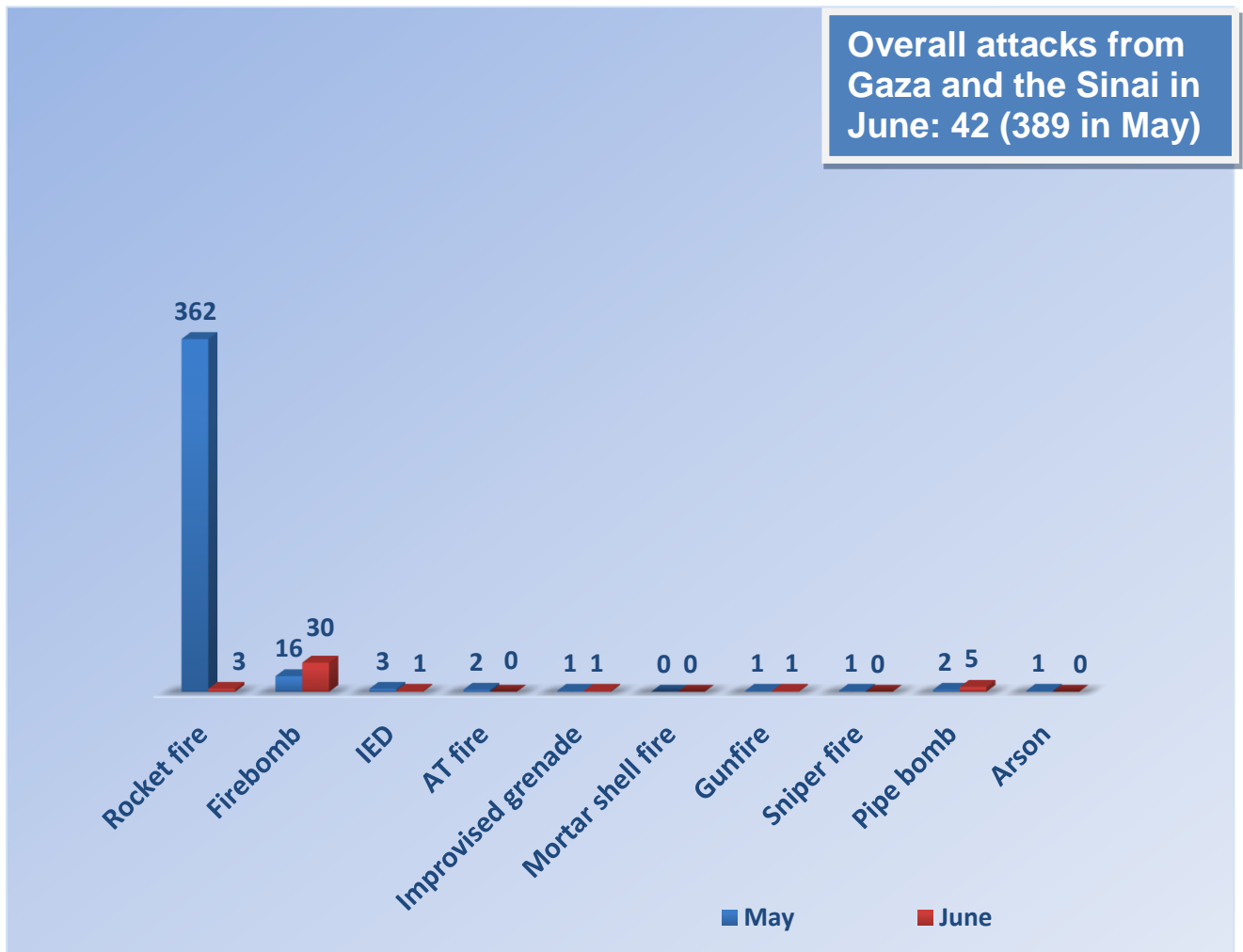
**Distribution of Terrorist Attacks in June 2019

**In Judea & Samaria and Jerusalem – 81 attacks: 53 firebombs; 15 pipe bombs; ten arsons; two grenades; and one instance of gunfire.**

In June 2019, 3 rocket-launching\* attacks were directed from the Gaza Strip at Israel, in contrast to 362 in May.

**\*Clarification:** The number of launchings is the number of rockets/mortar shells actually launched during one indirect fire attack. For example: one attack may consist of three launches, that is, three rockets / mortar shells, and so it will be counted as one attack and three launches.
